Commemorative Services

Special commemorative services are held to honor the anniversaries of the Self-Realization Fellowship Gurus. It is customary to bring a flower you have chosen as a symbol of your devotion and a monetary offering in an envelope as an expression of your loyalty and support of the Guru's work.

Monthly Temple Meeting

Meeting begins with a half-hour meditation. The minister then reads from *Autobiography of a Yogi* and discusses how we can apply its principles in our lives. Updates on temple activities and projects follow.

Day of Service

Day of Service begins with a short meditation led by the minister. We then break into work groups for cleaning, gardening, and maintenance projects. Lunch is provided at noon. This is a wonderful opportunity for spiritual fellowship and service to the Guru.
